Photographs of Existing Infrastructure: Before implementation, photographs showcasing the current state of the school's infrastructure.? Monitoring and Evaluation Plan: Strategy for assessing the effectiveness of the green initiatives post-implementation.? Utilization Certificate (UC): Document certifying the proper use of funds allocated for green initiatives.? Maintenance Plan: Long-term strategy for maintaining the green infrastructure and practices implemented.
