

# Welfare scheme for Salt Workers

## Schemes Details

<b>Department</b>	Labour, Skill Development and Employment Department
<b>Objective</b>	The scheme provides welfare and single window system at established 49 welfare centers for various other labour schemes for salt workers and other unorganized labourers at rural level.
<b>Purpose</b>	To improve the living and working conditions of salt workers by ensuring their health, economic security, and social welfare.
<b>Benefits</b>	Single window assistance and purchase of cycle at subsidized cost to rural labourers at 49 rural labor welfare centers
<b>Eligibility</b>	The person visiting must be a rural labourer preferably working in unorganized sector (such as agriculture, waste management, share croppers, salt pan workers etc)
<b>Documents Required</b>	Aadhaar Card (Identity proof) Ration Card or BPL Card (Proof of economic status) Residential Proof (Electricity bill, Voter ID, or Certificate from local authority) Caste Certificate (if applicable for reserved category benefits) Salt Worker Certificate or Proof of Employment (issued by Salt Commissioner/Employer or local Panchayat) Bank Passbook Copy (for DBT – Direct Benefit Transfer) Passport-size Photographs Income Certificate Health Certificate (for schemes related to health benefits) Children's School ID or Bonafide Certificate (for education-related schemes)
