


Free Medical Assistance scheme

Objective	The objective of Free Medical Assistance is to provide financial and healthcare support to economically weaker sections, ensuring access to essential medical treatment and reducing the burden of healthcare expenses. It aims to promote better health, social welfare, and equal healthcare opportunities for all.
Purpose	he purpose of Free Medical Assistance is to ensure that economically weaker sections receive necessary medical treatment without financial hardship, promoting better health and well-being for all.

Benefits	For anemia in women – ₹150 per case (only once per case) For maternity-related illnesses – ₹500 per case (only once) For cancer – ₹1,000 per month (until recovery) For tuberculosis (TB) – ₹500 per month (until recovery) For bleeding disorders – ₹800 per month (until recovery) For HIV/AIDS – ₹500 per month (until recovery)
Eligibility	Annual income limit for rural areas – ₹1,20,000/- Annual income limit for urban areas – ₹1,50,000/-
