Department	Collector Office (District Magistrate office)
Objective	The programme aims to meet the special development needs of the people living in remote and inaccessible areas situated near international border and to saturate the border areas with essential infrastructure through convergence of Central/State/BADP/Local schemes and participatory approach
Purpose	Construction of basic infrastructure and utilities in rural border areas
Benefits	The border area development plan is prepared by District Planning Office under leadership of District Collector and Guardian minister of the District. The funds are allocated to identified border districts for developing roads, other supporting infrastructure, toilets, schools, anganwadis, water supply facilities etc. and any other infrastructure for development of village.
Eligibility	The fund is only available to Gram Panchayats which are situated at 0-10 km from international border in any district.
Documents Required	Project Proposal;,Approval from State Government: Detailed Budget Estimate, Land Ownership and Legal Documents, Beneficiary Details, Environmental Clearance (if applicable), No Objection Certificate (NOC), Technical Feasibility Report, Security Clearance, Legal and Compliance Documents.
