Objective	To bridge the gap in availing services of obstetricians and gynecologist, in order to receive emergency obstetric care and institutional delivery in rural areas of the State. It aims to use the potential of a large number of private gynecologists who would provide free yet quality services to poor pregnant women in return for predetermined capitation-based payment from the government. The project envisioned that district level health officials would anchor and implement the project. For this, training in negotiation, consultation and networking were provided to the officials. To address this key vulnerability faced by the BPL population in the Gujarat, Mukhyamantri Amrutam "MA" Yojana was launched on 4th September, 2012 by Government of Gujarat.
Purpose	a health insurance scheme in Rajasthan that provides up to ₹25 lakh cashless treatment. It is available to low-income families, including those in Purpas, through online registration on the state's official portal.
