Purpose	The Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) is a pivotal public health initiative by the Government of India, aimed at reducing mortality and morbidity among children and pregnant women due to vaccine-preventable diseases. Launched in 1985, it has become an integral component of the National Health Mission since 2005 .?
Benefits	Free of cost vaccines for BCG, Polio, DPT, OPV, Typhoid, Measles and free Vitamin supplements to pregnant mothers
Eligibility	1) 0-5 year children, 2) Children up to 16 years for TT vaccine
Documents Required	Mother and Child Protection (MCP) Card Aadhaar Card Ration Card Pregnancy Certificate
