

# National Agriculture Insurance Scheme (NAIS) / Rashtriya Krishi Bima Yojana

## Schemes Details

<b>Department</b>	Agriculture, Farmers Welfare
<b>Objective</b>	In order to protect farmers and ensure their livelihood and income this scheme is formulated. The main objective of the scheme is to provide insurance to the 26 main types of notified crops. In case of natural calamity, pests, diseases etc.
<b>Purpose</b>	The purpose of the National Agriculture Insurance Scheme (NAIS) is to provide financial support to farmers in the event of crop failure due to natural calamities, pests, and diseases, thereby stabilizing their income and encouraging the adoption of modern farming practices.
<b>Benefits</b>	Financial coverage (insurance) from government in case of crop failure of notified crops
<b>Eligibility</b>	In principle, the scheme covers all the farmers who grow the notified crops in the notified areas. This also includes farmers who have borrowed loans from Financial institutions as well as all other farmers (non-loanee farmers)
<b>Documents Required</b>	Application Form, Land Records / Proof of Cultivation, Sowing Certificate, Bank Account Details, Photograph, Aadhaar Card or Other ID Proof,
