<b>Department</b>	Climate Change Department
<b>Objective</b>	"Reduce dependence on diesel for irrigation. Provide financial and water security to farmers. Promote the use of solar energy in agriculture. Enable farmers to earn additional income by selling surplus solar power to the grid. Contribute to India's commitment to increase the share of non-fossil fuel sources in its energy mix."
<b>Purpose</b>	To ensure energy security for farmers by promoting the use of solar energy for irrigation and farming, thereby reducing dependence on diesel and grid power.
<b>Benefits</b>	"Reduction in diesel consumption and associated costs. Lower electricity bills for farmers. Opportunity to earn additional income by selling surplus solar power. Promotion of sustainable and eco-friendly farming practices. Utilization of barren or uncultivable land for income-generating activities."
